STATEMENT ON JOINT INTERIM STUDY ON SEISMIC ACTIVITY HELD TODAY AT THE CAPITOL

Oklahoma City, OK – October 30, 2015 – Oklahoma Oil & Gas Association President Chad Warmington said today, “I want to thank the committees for holding the joint hearing and undertaking a very thorough review of the state’s response to the increase in seismicity. The committee members asked many good questions and took a serious interest in how regulators and industry are trying to address this very significant situation. The quality and quantity of information presented, compared to last year’s interim study on the same subject, was remarkable. That is a testament to the tremendous effort being put forth by the Corporation Commission and the Oklahoma Geological Survey. It’s very clear that protecting Oklahoma citizens is priority number one, but what’s not been lost is the goal to balance their actions so as to not unjustly impair the production of Oklahoma’s vast oil and gas resources. We agree that although the data is beginning to show a reduction in seismic activity, the work is not done. We remain committed to working with all parties to provide as much information as we can to support good science-based regulatory decisions.”
