



## Oil and Gas Industry Hosts 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual STACK Summer Classic Pig Show

*Fundraiser benefits western Oklahoma youth*



**KINGFISHER, Okla.** (July 11, 2018) – More than 100 young Oklahomans will show their best pigs at the 2018 STACK Summer Classic Pig Show. The event will take place Saturday, July 21, at the [Kingfisher Country Fairgrounds](#).

For the second year, [the Oklahoma Oil & Gas Association](#) (OKOGA) will sponsor the event, along with 10 member companies.

Because of these sponsorships, all entry fees go directly to prize money and payback of entry fees.

Prizes at the show include \$1,000 for the grand champion and \$500 for the reserve champion, along with awards for breed champions, including Yeti coolers. The overall purse is expected to top \$10,000 in cash and prizes. Exhibitors will also be entered into drawings for show supplies.

At the STACK Summer Classic, cards are due at 4:30 p.m., and the show begins at 6 p.m. Spencer Scotten will judge. Area residents, participants and their families are invited to enjoy a free meal at 5 p.m.

jobs and economic development. It's only natural OKOGA members would also support the young people who will feed our state and our nation in the future."
