



OIPA and OKOGA Joint Statement on Oklahoma General Election Results

OKLAHOMA CITY (Nov. 6, 2018) – Oklahoma’s oil and natural gas industry issued the following joint statement from Chad Warmington, President of OKOGA and Berry Mullennix, Chairman of OIPA, on the 2018 general election results:
