President Trump's Executive Order to Unleash American Energy

OKLAHOMA CITY, Okla.: Following President Trump's signing of two executive orders to develop critical energy infrastructure and unleash American energy, OIPA-OKOGA president Chad Warmington released the following statement:

"Expanding America's energy infrastructure and clearing unnecessary regulatory hurdles for liquefied natural gas export, directly strengthens Oklahoma's economy," **OIPA-OKOGA president Chad Warmington said.** "As one of the nation's leading oil and natural gas producers, Oklahomans are proud to develop the energy that moves our economy towards achieving energy dominance.

"Too often, unnecessary political roadblocks have delayed or even suspended key energy projects. This uncertainty jeopardizes investment, good-paying jobs, and increases costs for hard-working families throughout the country and Oklahoma.

"Modernizing and expanding pipeline infrastructure networks is critical to connecting Oklahoma-produced energy with domestic and international markets – actions that will spur the oil and natural gas development needed to support good-paying jobs, drive tax revenues and sustain long-term economic growth."
